

2022 Program Development Committee Youth Ambassador Application

Serving as a Program Development Committee (PDC) Youth Ambassador is an opportunity for youth who have an interest in helping their local communities and would like to develop their personal leadership skills. Working alongside the Extension Agents and PDC members, the Youth Ambassador would serve an integral role in identifying needs of the local community, developing programming activities, and sharing the resources available through the West Plains Extension District.

PDC Youth Ambassadors will serve a one-year term and can select to apply for one of the following focus areas: Agriculture/Horticulture and Natural Resources; Community Vitality; Family and Consumer Sciences; or 4-H Youth Development. PDC meetings will occur throughout the year (not to exceed 4 total meetings per year). Applications are due **December 10, 2021**, to the Extension Office. Applicant must be 16 or older by January 1, 2022. One applicant per county (Finney and Scott County) will be selected per focus area by the West Plains Extension Board.
