Terms of Scholarship

1. Resident of Finney County or Finney County 4-H member.
2. Enrolled in 4-H for five years, including senior year or senior 4-H year.
3. “Full-time” student status required and is defined as enrolled in 12 credit hours.
4. Student must maintain a cumulative 2.7 GPA to receive scholarship.
6. **Mary Jo Williams 4-H Scholarship is a one-time \$1000 amount.**

Requests for Scholarship

- In order to receive scholarships, student **must submit proof of enrollment with student name clearly listed** by the due date of **September 15th**, to the Kansas 4-H Foundation.
- Failure to submit these items will result in the loss of scholarship. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
