COVERED PAINT CAN

Materials:

Unused gallon-size paint can
3- 11" x 11" sheets of scrapbook paper
Ribbon and decorations of your choice.
Spray adhesive



Directions

- 1. Wash and dry the paint can.
- 2. Lightly mist the back side of each sheet with spray adhesive just before applying it to the can.
- 3. Align one sheet of paper along the upper edge of the back of the can, just under the upper lip, then smooth the sheet onto the can.
- 4. Ues the bottom lip of the can as a guide to score the paper with your thumbnail or the smooth bottom of a crafts knife.
- 5. Cut away the excess paper along the socred edge using a very sharp crafts knife.
- 6. To fit the paper around the handles, smooth the paper by pushing your thumb up to the handle; use a crafts knife to slice through from that point to the edge of the paper.
- 7. Continue pushing the paper close to the handle and trimming away the excess as you go to make a neat opening.
- 8. Cover the front of the can by repeating Steps 1 and 2.
- 9. For lid, trim a sheet of paper slightly larger than the can lid and mist the back with spray adhesive.
- 10. Attach sheet to the lid and score around inner rim; carefully cut away excess paper.
- 11. Optional: cut 8"-10" strips of fabric or ribbon and tie around handle of can.
- 12. Add fresh or artificial berries or greenery.
- 13. Add your own touch and decorate as you see fit.

Fabric covered can

- 1. Cut fabric $\frac{1}{4}$ " - $\frac{1}{2}$ " longer then the height of the can, and press it under.
- 2. For a neat seam at the back, allow for extra fabric to overlap, and press it under, too.
